



Michael Lohberg Scholarship

The Coral Springs Swim Club (CSSC) shall establish a scholarship account with monies raised from fundraising events specific to the Lohberg Scholarship Fund.

Each year, eligible high school swimmers shall complete the application available at the CSSC website and deliver it to the front office at the Coral Springs Aquatic Complex. Applications will be accepted from February – April 1st 2016. The Scholarship Committee (Owner, Head Coach, 2-3 board members) will review the applications and forward the final results to the CSSC board for approval. Recipients will be notified at the annual swim banquet and funds will be deposited in the appropriate accounts at the winners' designated universities.

All awards will be provided on an objective and non-discriminatory basis using criteria approved by the Coral Springs Swim Club, Inc. Board of Directors. No donors or their relatives will control the selection process either directly or indirectly.

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Michael Lohberg Award is to recognize swimmers in the CSSC who exemplify outstanding achievement in school, athletics, and sportsmanship.

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Applicants must be current high school seniors who plan to graduate in the spring and attend a college or university by the fall of the same year.

2.2 Applicants must be current CSSC club members in good standing who are up to date on all club fees, registration, and escrow account.

2.3 Applicants must have been CSSC club members for at least the previous 24 consecutive months at the time of graduation and must have regularly represented CSSC at club swim meets.

2.4 Applicants must uphold the CSSC Code of Conduct at all times, including:

- offering congratulations to opponents (win or lose)
- cheering on their teammates
- displaying proper behavior and respect to team members, coaches, officials, administrators, competitors, parents, volunteers, and public.



3. REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 Official school transcript sealed. Applicants must maintain a minimum cumulative high school unweighted GPA of 3.0 [see options A, B and C below].
- 3.2 Completed *CSSC Michael Lohberg Scholarship Application*
- 3.3 One letter of recommendation from a school, religious or community organization. This letter must be signed by a non-relative. Letter cannot be from a CSSC coach. Letter must be submitted in sealed envelope.
- 3.4 Approval from CSSC coach

Preference will be given to swimmers who demonstrate excellent work ethic in practice and at meets; who exemplify good sportsmanship both in and out of the water; and who promote a positive team spirit, which includes being humble and courageous in defeat.

4. AWARDS

Funds will be awarded according to the following criteria:

Option A

Up to \$500- The swimmer has held continuous FGC Swimming Registration under CSSC for the last 24 -35 months and has an unweighted GPA of 3.0 and higher.

Option B

Up to \$1000- The swimmer has held continuous FGC Swimming Registration under CSSC for the last 36-47 months and has an unweighted GPA of 3.0 and higher.

Option C

Up to \$1500- The swimmer has held continuous FGC Swimming Registration under CSSC for the last 48 or more months and has an unweighted GPA of 3.0 and higher.

5. MICHAEL LOHBERG SPONSORSHIP GUIDELINES AND ENFORCEMENT

- 5.1 This document provides guidelines and establishes procedures for all CSSC Swimmers who choose to apply for the Michael Lohberg Scholarship Award on behalf of Coral Springs Swim Club. A CSSC all-year swimmer is required to comply with these guidelines in order to receive allocated funds.
- 5.2 The purpose of these guidelines is to:
 - Ensure all Swimmers have a clear and consistent understanding of policies and procedures for the Scholarship Award.



5.3 Responsibility

Each Swimmer has the responsibility for fully completing the application and submitting all requirements by the established deadline.

5.4 Enforcement

CSSC assumes no obligation to award funds to swimmers that are not in compliance with this policy.

5.6 Policy review

This policy will be reviewed annually or as required in order to ensure that the terms are current, fair, and representative of relevant economic conditions.
